

Fishing Licenses

Nonresident sport fishing license are issued for 1, 3, 7 or 14 days

You may buy & print out a fishing license online at:

Note: You must carry your license with you whenever you are fishing – so if you purchase ahead of time, don't forget to bring it with you.

In **Sitka**, you may buy a license (and gear) at Orion Sporting Goods, Lakeside Plaza, 705 Halibut Point Road (907) 747-3541 or Murray Pacific, 475 Katlian Ave (907) 747-3171.

In **Juneau**, you may buy a license at the Western Auto Marine store - 5165 Glacier Hwy (907) 780-4909 or the Fred Meyer Store - 8181 Old Glacier Highway (907) 789-6500 (stop on the way into town from the Airport).

Or

You may wait and buy a fishing license once you are onboard.

Glacier Viewing Around Juneau



During your Boat Company trip, we'll take you to view glaciers from the vessel. Weather permitting, we'll take skiffs and explore closer, pausing to observe seals and their pups hauled out on ice floes, and pick up glacier ice for cocktails. If you would like to walk on a glacier or view it by plane or helicopter you'll want to arrange to do this while in Juneau. A number of outfitters in Juneau offer "Flightseeing" –
